The Bill & Yvonne Boettcher Golf Scholarship was created to provide educational opportunities for promising young students from Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin. The scholarship(s) will be awarded to a Sturgeon Bay High School senior with a demonstrated financial need for their first year of post-secondary education. The applicant must have maintained at least a "B" average throughout high school and been involved in community service.

The applicant must also be in their second year of participation (or have participated previously for two years) in the golf program at Sturgeon Bay High School. If there is no worthy applicant that meets the two year golf program requirement, applicants with only one year of participation in the golf program may be considered.
